

Making Nature Paintbrushes

What you need

A collection of pencil sized sticks or twigs



Wool or string and scissors



A creative eye for gathering paint brush tops



How to make them

Making your nature brushes is super easy! Simply cut a 30cm length of wool or string. Lay out your stick and choose which brush topper you are going to use. Our favourites are moss, leaves, long grass and feathers. Using your cut wool or string, tie them to the top of your sticks so they are securely attached.

You can then use them dipped into paint and make different shapes, textures and patterns on your paper. On a hot day you can try dipping them into water and paint patterns onto an outdoor concrete floor or patio.
